OPEN PUBLIC HEARING:

Ms. Vignola – I would like to know if the Board is going to pass a policy for students who refuse to take the PARCC and make accommodations for them.

Dr. Kildow – we have yet to receive direction from the State Department of Education.

Ms. Vignola – how are the other districts passing this type of policy?

Dr. Kildow – we will follow the direction from the State Department of Education.

Ms. Vignola – I am asking, how are other districts passing this?

Mr. Salerno – after much discussion, the Board decided that we are not going to pass a resolution allowing students not to take the PARCC. There are other items that need to be considered. Mr. Salerno read a statement from NJ School Boards regarding PARCC.

Ms. Vignola – I have parental rights – according to the 14th Amendment. My child does not have to take the test. My child is not going to sit there in front of a computer.

Dr. Kildow – wait until we get closer to the date. They have testimony coming up next week regarding PARCC and possibly in February we might get information on how to handle students refusing to take the test.

Ms. Clark – each board is responsible for their policies. There are over 600 districts in New Jersey. The number of districts who implemented a policy with respect to PARCC is negligible. It is the district's responsibility to implement PARCC. The district does not have the ability to opt out. The PARCC Commission is meeting on January 26th thru the 28th. You have the right to attend. Additional guidance regarding parents opt out may come out of the meeting.

Ms. Buckman – the Euclid school PTA would like to do a school tool box for next year. Do you know when the supply list is expected to come out?

Ms. Doheny – Each supply list is done by the building administrator. Please contact Mr. Sickels.

Ms. Vignola – my emails are not being responded to.

Dr. Kildow – I have responded to all the emails you have sent to me. I don't respond to you when I'm copied on it.
